Place an infinity symbol by things that you can connect to what you already know or your background knowledge.



Draw arrows to make connections to text or ideas.



Put numbers by arguments, important ideas, examples or key details.

LEFT MARGIN

Put 'summary notes' of what you have read in the left hand margin.

RIGHT MARGIN
Use the right margin to analyze what you have read...DOK 4.
